The Church of the Annunciation believes in the worth, ability and integrity of our youth. We have therefore established our Church and Community awards program to recognize the outstanding contributions by young people in church activities, school, and in the community at large. It is our hope that through this recognition we will encourage youth to value service and commitment to their community.

The Parish Council will offer several awards every year to outstanding young people. These awards are not scholarships but "Awards of Merit" to be used to further aims and purposes in achieving educational goals.

**Eligibility and Qualifications:**

Any student who is currently attending a middle school, high school or College/trade School during the past academic year is eligible. Students who received awards last year are kindly asked not to apply a 2<sup>nd</sup> year in a row, to allow other candidates to be recognized this year. To be considered for the award the applicant must have fulfilled the following:

**Applicant:**

- A. Must be an active member of an Annunciation youth activity; or, if away from home must be a participant in some form of Orthodox Church activity.
- B. Applicant or at least one parent must be a member of the Church of the Annunciation and in good standing.

**Award Disbursement:**

The Parish Council will ask a committee of community members to review all completed applications and choose candidates. The specific age group and amount of individual awards will be presented based on grade level in school or college, and merits of the applicants

**Criteria and priority:**

Supporting documentation should address the applicant's commitment towards church, school and community endeavors with specific references to the areas cited below. Priority will be given to all spiritual endeavors. Letters of reference will play a significant role in verifying participation and selecting the awardees.

1. **Service:** Active participation in church, school, the community, with a high degree of cooperation, courtesy and consideration for others. Examples: participation in youth events, participation in organization fundraisers & fellowship, documented volunteering during festival from section leaders, volunteering at Greek school.....

2. **Dependability:** Applicant must have executed responsibilities with truthfulness, loyalty and punctuality.
3. **Leadership:** Applicant must have demonstrated ability to lead with self-control, dignity and responsibility.
4. **Clear Sense of Purpose:** Applicant must have pursued selected endeavors with sincerity and integrity.

**The candidate must:**

1. Complete application.
2. Obtain two letters of recommendation from individuals in leadership positions. One letter must be from the applicant's Church, and one from their current school, excluding relatives.
